Seabrook - Daniel P. Chatigny, 87, of Seabrook, passed away on Monday, September 30, 2024, at Rockingham Country Rehabilitation and Nursing Center in Brentwood. He was the loving husband of Mary Ellen (Roche) Chatigny.

Born in Exeter on April 10, 1937, Daniel was the son of the late Joseph and Susan (McGinnis) Chatigny. Raised and educated in Exeter, Daniel attended St. Michael's Grammar School, Exeter High School and went on to enlist in the United States Navy, mostly in the Mediterranean. From there, Daniel worked for forty years as a cement finisher and belonged to the Bricklayers & Trowel Trades International Union. Daniel completed countless projects at many construction sites in New Hampshire including the Seabrook Station Nuclear Power Plant.

In addition to his wife, Daniel is survived by his sons, Thomas John Chatigny of Seabrook and Joseph William Chatigny and his wife Dremessa of Barrington.
