He always waved and said hi no matter how many times he saw you that day, and willing to help if needed.

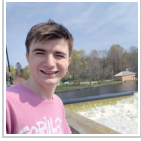
Danny always left a lasting impression to everyone he met, a very kind, genuine unforgettable man that everyone loved.
