May 5, 1964 - January 20, 2015

Rye – Darwin W. White, 50, of Rye, died Tuesday, January 20, 2015 at the Exeter Hospital with his loving and devoted family by his side. He fought a 15 month battle with stage 4 pancreatic cancer.

He was born May 5, 1964 in Huntsville, AL, a son of Carmela Mazzaglia-Trembley of Hampton and the late Billy Joe White of Huntsville. AL.

Darwin was raised in Salem and graduated from Salem High with the Class of 1983. He served as a lifeguard at Hampton Beach in the 1980s where he received special recognition for saving the life of a stranded swimmer. He went on to attend college in Maryland and later returned to Salem. After holding various positions in the computer industry, Darwin started his own business in 2005, Ocean Electronics of Portsmouth. He married the love of his life, Jessica (LeBlanc) White in 2002 and the family moved to Rye in 2006. Darwin was always a competitive swimmer and had served as President of the Great Bay Masters Swimming Club. He was also a lifelong, passionate golfer. While in Rye he was a faithful communicant of the St. Theresa Parish.

Darwin is survived by his loving wife, Jessica, his beautiful daughter, Jenea and his adoring son, Dominic. He also leaves behind his mother, his brother Thomas White of Orlando, FL and his sister Kirsten White and her spouse Ashley Howard-White of Haverhill, MA. He is also survived by his in-laws,

SGT Justin Murray, USMC, and his wife Megan of Dover and Jennette Lofton and her husband Towan of Washington, DC, as well as several nieces and nephews and many close friends.

He was predeceased by his father Billy Joe, as well as his stepfather, Edward Tompkins, who raised Darwin and whom he loved very much.

Visiting hours will be from 5 to 8 PM on Friday, January 30, 2015 in the Remick & Gendron Funeral Home – Crematory, 811 Lafayette Rd., Hampton. 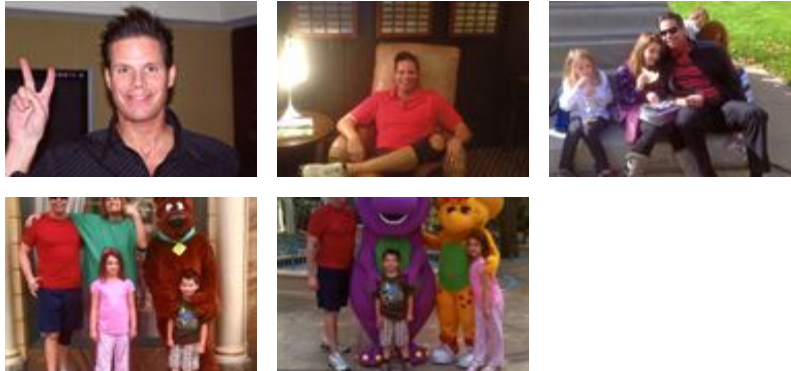

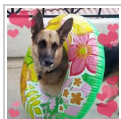
