Hampton Falls – David P. Benoit, 75, of Hampton Falls, died Tuesday, October 27, 2020 at Portsmouth Regional Hospital after a period of failing health. He was born in Lawrence, MA April 3, 1945 the son of the late Philip and Ruth (Nimmo) Benoit.

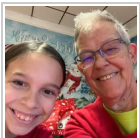
