January 6, 1947 - December 20, 2014

Hampton – David S. Keir, father of three loving daughters and devoted wife, Pamela Keir, passed away at his home, surrounded by his affectionate family, Saturday, December 20, 2014 from a short but aggressive battle with cancer. His parting came and went quickly but was ultimately peaceful and filled with love.

David was raised in Danville and graduated from Sanborn Seminary in Kingston. He received his bachelor's degree from the University of Irvine, Irvine, CA and his master's degree from Plymouth State College. He was a veteran of the US Army serving as a paratrooper and medic with the 82nd Airborne and has been a loyal member of the Disabled American Veterans. For the past 26 years, David and his wife, Pamela have owned and operated the Riviera Motor Inn at Hampton Beach.

In his last 50 years he has been avid motorcycle enthusiastic with memberships to multiple BMW motorcycle clubs in Maine, Vermont and New Hampshire and has received a variety of awards and certificates for his days of riding. Most recently, he earned the U.S.A. BMW Motorrad's 500,000 Mile Award, which earns their "Ultimate Riding Machine" title.

He leaves his wife of 34 years, Pamela J. (Hayes) Keir, three daughters, Allison Keir, Meredith Keir and Aimee Morrill, two grandsons, Jason Nugent

and Trenton Morrill, brothers, sisters, and several extended family members, including his brotherly nephew, Michael McDonough.

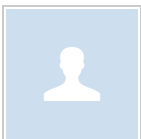
