Hampton – David H. Williams, 75 of Hampton, formerly of Stratham, died Friday, February 6, 2015 at the Portsmouth Regional Hospital following a brief illness.

He was born in Paden City, WV December 30, 1939 and was the son of the late Paul A. and Agnes P. (Robinson) Williams.

David was a Vietnam veteran and was a Staff Sergeant, serving over nine years in the US Air Force. His military training, led him into a career in communication and sound engineering. He and his late wife, Bonnie Williams established and operated William's Communications Services, Inc. installing communications systems throughout the region.

He resided 25 years in Stratham before moving to Hampton in 2000. He served on the Stratham Volunteer Fire Department and was an EMT. He was very active in the Community of Stratham, including volunteering on the Stratham Fair Committee, being Cub Scout and Boy Scout Leader in the Town of Stratham for many years and was active in the Stratham Community Church as well.

A mason, David was a member of Saint James Lodge #102 F. & A.M. of Hampton, serving as Worshipful Master in 1994.

David shared 41 years of marriage with his wife, Bonnie Ann (Blackstun) Williams, who died in 2010.

Family members include their daughter, Tamara P. Demmons and her husband, Michael of Portsmouth and two grandsons, Andrew and Michael Demmons, Jr.

Services will be held at 6:30 P.M. Wednesday, February 11t, 2015 at the Remick & Gendron Funeral Home-Crematory, 811 Lafayette Road, Hampton. 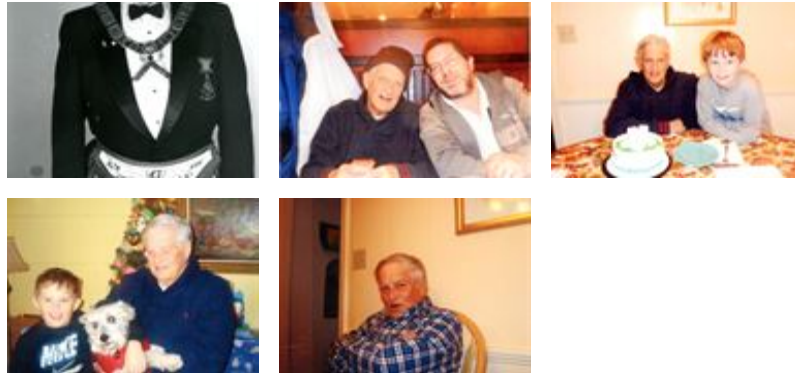
