Hampton Falls, NH – Deborah S. Ingham, 47, of Hampton Falls, died peacefully Friday, January 30, 2015 at her home with her family at her side after a courageous fight against cancer.

She was born in Melrose, MA June 24, 1967 a daughter of Roy Crosby of Exeter and the late Barbara (Bitzer) Crosby.

Raised in West Peabody, she graduated from Peabody High School with the Class of 1986. Following graduation she attended and graduated from Essex Aggie College with the Class of 1988, where she earned a degree in fashion design and interior decorating.

She worked as the marketing manager for Ryder Transportation for 26 years before her illness forced an early retirement in 2013.

Deborah greatest pleasure was spending time with her family, especially her two daughters. She enjoyed cooking, trips to Disney, skiing and weekends at the lake house on Ossipee Lake, where she was known as the t-shirt lady.

“ I just learned of Debbie’s passing and my heart is very heavy. I would like to share a story about the one time we met. On February 4, 2010 I was on a flight from Nevada to Newark NJ returning from my first business trip after my wife Jenny was killed. I was so deeply wounded – to this day I start to weep when I think about the overwhelming darkness that surrounded me. Life had little meaning and I could not see a way to survive. I had just started reading a book “I Wasn’t Ready to Say Goodbye”, which is about surviving, coping, and healing after a sudden loss. I was very emotional. A woman sitting next to me would occasionally offer me a tissue. I don’t recall saying a single word until we were landing when she lean over to me and asked if I was OK. I could barely talk. I briefly responded - “I lost my wife”. Sensing my pain she started to softly cry. We had a brief exchange and she told me she recently lost her Mom to lung cancer. As we were parting I handed her the book I was reading and told her I hoped it would help her - we exchanged business cards. On my drive home, she sent me a text expressing how touched she was and offered to pray for my healing. I vividly remember pulling over to the side of the road and feeling a glimmer of hope in my soul. I can’t explain it but that simple note provided me the light I needed to see again. Over the subsequent months she would regularly send me messages of expectation and friendship – many arrived at night when it was the most difficult for me. Although I never saw her again, nor had we even talked on the phone, I had shared with her how much she helped me – she saved my life.
