



## Deidre L. Yavorosky

July 14, 1945 - June 22, 2021

Fremont- Deidre L. Yavorosky, 75, of Fremont and formerly of Seabrook, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, June 22, 2021, with loving family at her side, at the Colonial Poplin Nursing Home in Fremont. She was born in Newburyport, MA on July 14, 1945, a daughter of the late Vincent A. and Barbara L. (Knowles) Yavorosky.

Deidre was raised in Seabrook and graduated from Winnacunnet High School in 1963. After graduating high school, she went on to earn her Bachelor's Degree at Ithaca College in New York and furthered her education at Cornell and UNH. She moved back to NH and worked as an art teacher for Seabrook Elementary for 10 years between 1974 and 1984. After she left Seabrook Elementary, she lived in a number of places working in real estate, including Provincetown, MA, and back in Ithaca, NY. In addition to working in real estate, she was an account executive with a local Ithaca radio station and owned and operated Charjans Gift Store. While managing her gift store, Deidre founded the local chapter of "The Dressing Room," an organization that helped under-privileged women "dress for success." She was also affiliated with several women's and professional clubs in the Ithaca area. Deidre retired in 2005 and returned to NH in 2019 due to failing health.

Deidre was a serious player of board games and could play Backgammon and Rummy-O with friends and family for hours. She was a lifelong artist, in later

years designing and selling handcrafted jewelry. She was a true animal lover and adored her dogs.

She is survived by her sister Jo-Anne Lowe and her husband Thomas of Seabrook, niece Sarah Chappelow and her husband James of Northfield, and several cousins and close friends.
