



Delmont C. Harvey

February 15, 1931 - August 2, 2025

Hampton – Delmont C. Harvey, 94, of Hampton, passed away peacefully at Portsmouth Hospital on Saturday, August 2, 2025.

He was born in Millinocket, Maine, on February 15, 1931, to the late Earl and Myrtle (Tibbetts) Harvey. At the age of 17, Delmont enlisted in the United States Air Force, beginning a life of travel and service that brought him around the world. He spent time living in Australia, the Marshall Islands, Illinois, Washington DC, New Mexico, and Texas before joining the Air Force Reserves in 1963.

While stationed near Cape Cod in 1953, he met the love of his life, Rita (Pellegrini). They married and shared 55 years of devoted marriage until her passing in 2014. In 1965, they made their home in Hampton, where Delmont remained for the rest of his life.

Delmont worked for Combustion Engineering - Avery for 20 years and later at Bossard Metrics. Known for his strong work ethic, he was admired for his dedication both at work and at home.

He loved gardening and camping and especially looked forward to his family's annual camping trip, a tradition he cherished deeply.

Delmont is survived by his children: Ellen Harvey, Karen Zirkle and her

husband Robert, David Harvey, Thomas Harvey and his wife Susan, Paul Harvey and his wife Patti - Jean. He was a proud grandfather to Kali Constantine and her husband Peter, Emma Lantzy and her husband Ryan, Miranda, Catherine, Isabella, Jeremy, Adelina, Madeline, and Michael Harvey, and a beloved great-grandfather to Aiden and Margot Lantzy.

He is also survived by his sister Sharon Beane and her husband Sherwin, and sister-in-law Christine Powers, and many nieces and nephews.

Delmont and his wife Rita will be laid to rest together in a private ceremony at the New Hampshire State Veterans Cemetery in Boscawen.
