



## Dennis S. Carroll

August 28, 1938 - April 28, 2015

Kensington - Dennis Stephen "Denny" Carroll, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, April 28, 2015 with his loving family by his side.

Dennis was born August 28, 1938 in Saxonville, MA, a son of the late Stephen A. and Frances (Moore) Carroll.

A longtime resident of Framingham, MA, he moved to NH in 1978 and opened The Vacuum Cleaner Hospital in Seabrook until his retirement in 2000. He was a resident of Kensington for the past 30 years.

Dennis was a proud American and spoke often of his service in the US Navy. He circumnavigated the world aboard the diesel submarine, USS Gudgeon (SS-567) and continued supporting his fellow servicemen and woman through The Wounded Warrior Project. He excelled at sports in high school and was a lifelong fan of the Boston Red Sox. Dennis was also a friend of Bill W.

Faddoul and her husband Andrew of Marlborough, MA and Stephen A Carroll, II, and his wife Heidi of Seabrook; his caring ex-wife Rosalie Yerardi of Marlborough; his
