



Dennis J. Theberge

July 14, 1952 - March 23, 2023

It is with profound sadness that we have to say these words. Dennis Joseph Theberge, age 70 of North Hampton, NH and Fort Myers, FL passed away at Hope Hospice House in Cape Coral, FL on March 23, 2023 after a private 18-month battle with lung cancer. His wife Linda and son Christian were at his side.

Anyone who spent time with Dennis has a story to tell about him, but Dennis was the greatest storyteller of all. He could get anyone to crack a smile, and if you talked with him, he gave you his undivided attention.

Dennis was born on July 14, 1952 in Lawrence, Massachusetts to the late Joseph and Theresa (Desjardins) Theberge. The family resided in Andover, MA for many years before moving briefly to Lachine, Quebec, where Dennis made many enjoyable memories. The family later moved to Wilbraham, MA where Den graduated from Minnechaug High School in 1970. The family relocated to Greenland, NH and Dennis attended Heavy Equipment Operator School. Dennis first worked in the local seacoast area on the high level 95 bridge and for the McKenna's in York. Dennis also spent many years working for Custom Pools, traveling around New England digging pools. He later worked for Marathon Construction and Middlesex Corporation, doing heavy highway construction. Eventually, he went to work with Gove Construction out of Portsmouth, working locally and finished up his career with PK Brown in

Portsmouth. Dennis' last project was pro bono work; helping his son and daughter-in-law clear the land where they've since built a home for themselves. Though he won't get to see the project in its final glory, his deftness in an excavator laid the groundwork to make it possible.

Dennis had a zest for life, he loved cars - he asked Linda out so that he could drive her car ('78 Mustang Cobra) and the rest was history... Dennis and Linda were married in 1982 and would have shared 41 years of marriage this May. He loved going to Hampton Beach, and boating on Lake Winnepesaukee and Great Bay. Dennis and Linda spent many years traveling to the Caribbean together and were fortunate to both retire early. The two enjoyed their retirement lifestyle; ultimately purchasing a "let's get out of winter" condo in Florida a couple years ago, where they could enjoy the company of fabulous new friends who also couldn't resist year-round summer and sunshine.

Dennis loved his family fiercely. In addition to his wife Linda, son Christian, and daughter-in-law Carly Monahan, Dennis is survived by his siblings; Noel Luzi, Carol Ronci and husband Samuel, Joseph Theberge and wife Terry, and Roseanne Lago and husband Steve. With his siblings came nieces and nephews; Christine Luzi and husband Kris, Eric Ronci, Ryan Ronci, Steven Lago and wife Julie, and Brett Lago. The great nieces and nephew held a special place in Uncle Den's heart; they are Lilah, Tess, Hannah and Enio.

A favorite quote of Dennis' reads:

"Life should not be a journey to the grave, with the intention of arriving safely in a pretty and well preserved body, but rather to skid in sideways, body thoroughly used up, totally worn out, and screaming out loud 'Wow! What a Ride!'" - We had one hell of a good ride, Den.

class father, husband, brother, uncle and friend.

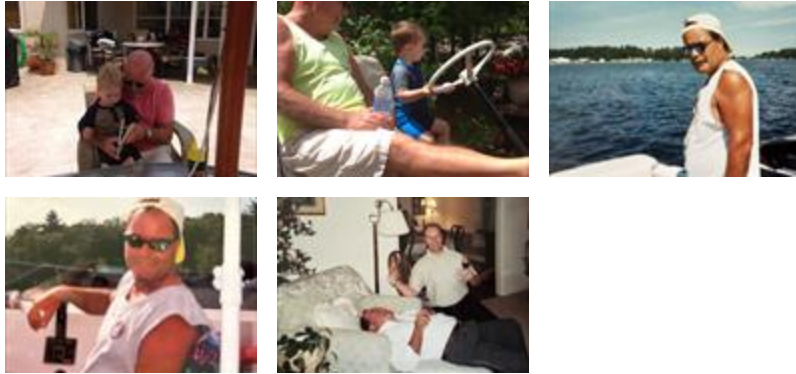

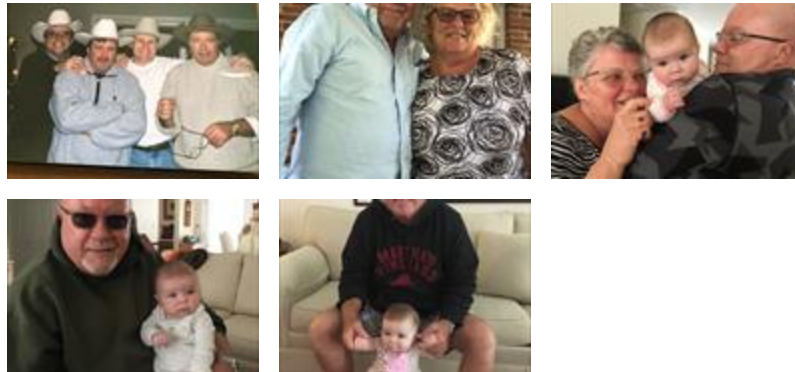

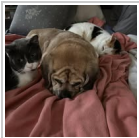
