Greenland - Devereaux Jonpaul Duguay, 2 1/2 years old, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, May 28th at Exeter Hospital with his parents and grandmother by his side.

Devereaux ("Reaux") was born on October 28th, 2020, at York Hospital to loving parents Christian and Elise (Feugill) Duguay and older sister Adeline (5), of Greenland, NH.

Devereaux can be described as "pure light". He was always smiling, being silly and making others laugh. He was brave and a risk taker, willing to try new things and go on any new adventure. He gave the sweetest kisses and biggest hugs. He brought so much joy and touched many lives.

If not playing at home, Reaux was often either spending time at various playgrounds (swings or slides were his favorite) or at his grandmother's house, where he got to birdwatch and look at all the people, cars, and dogs of Hampton Beach. He loved planes, firetrucks/police, racecars, trains, motorcycles, buses, construction vehicles... anything with wheels that went VROOM or had a siren.

Reaux always wanted to be outside and rarely liked to "go home". He liked kicking a soccer ball, practicing t-ball with his sister, and popping bubbles.

During the summer he loved playing at the water table or building sandcastles at the beach. He enjoyed going to storytime at the library, farms to see animals, and play areas where he could run around.

Reaux loved to read books, work on puzzles, build with blocks, play with trains, take magnets off the fridge, put stickers on every surface and watch TV. His favorite shows were Blaze, Paw Patrol, and Bluey. He had many cars, dump trucks and various vehicles that he especially loved to line up in a row, often taking up the whole couch or coffee table.

Our sweet boy was loved by all that met him.

His laugh was infectious, and you couldn't be anything but happy around him. Reaux's life was short, but his imprint was big. Everything about him will forever be missed.

In addition to his mom, dad, and sister, Devereaux is survived by his grandparents, Richard & Denise Feugill (Gallant) of Hampton, NH and -Paul & Candace Duguay (Zaborski) of Warwick, RI and his great grand-parents, Donald & Marilyn Zaborski. 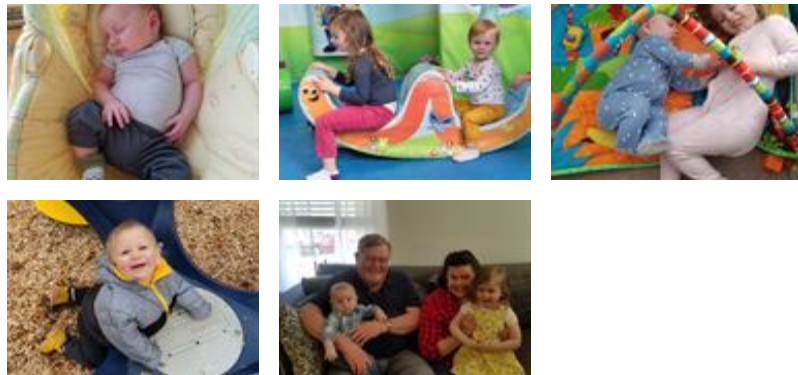

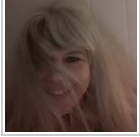
