



## Donald H. Chase

June 2, 1926 - March 11, 2014

Hampton Falls - Donald H. Chase, 87, of Hampton Falls, died March 11, 2014 at his home after a brief illness.

He was born June 2, 1926 in Newburyport, Mass., a son of the late Harry and Edith (Smith) Chase.

Raised in Seabrook, he graduated from Amesbury High School and was a veteran of WWII and Korea serving with the US Navy. In 1958 he graduated from the University of New Hampshire with a bachelors' degree in forestry. He later served with the US Air Force and with the US Army Reserves.

Mr. Chase was employed as a realty specialist for the US Dept. of Interior Fish & Wildlife Service working out of the Boston office retiring with over 40 years of government service.

Earlier he had also worked as head sawyer at his father's saw mill.

He made his home in Hampton Falls since 1956, was a member of the First Baptist Church, the Grange and Historical Society all of Hampton Falls and in his earlier years was a volunteer fire fighter with the Hampton Falls Fire Dept. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, a member of St. James Lodge No. 102 F. & A.M. of Hampton, Scottish Rite Bodies Valley of Portsmouth and Dover and the Bektash Temple Shrine, Concord.

Mr. Chase was a supporter of many veterans' organizations, was a member of the Coast Guard Auxiliary and at one time held his pilots' license.

He was the husband of the late Betty-Lou (Campbell) Chase who died in 1992 and the father of Dorothy C. Hubbard who died in 2001.

Family members include his daughter, Jennifer K. Ireton and her husband David and their children, Sydney, Brandon and Shaun all of Rockaway, NJ, his son, Duncan Chase of Concord, his son-in-law, Henry "Hy" Hubbard and his children, Jennifer and April and his wife Heidi, nieces and nephews.

He was also predeceased by his brother, Josiah Chase and his sister, Virginia Randall.
