



## Donald R. Littlefield Jr.

January 27, 1947 - October 4, 2015

Seabrook, NH – Donald R. “Capt. Don” Littlefield, Jr., 68, of Seabrook, died on Sunday, October 4, 2015 after an extended illness while at Beth Israel Deaconess Hospital in Boston. His devoted family was by his bedside.

He was born January 27, 1947 in Haverhill, MA, a son of the late Donald R. and Roancy (Gibbs) Littlefield, Sr.

Don was a lifelong resident of Seabrook. He married the love of his life, Helen (Perkins) Littlefield in 1965 and together, raised their family in Seabrook. As soon as he was old enough, he went to work on the Littlefield Charter Boats and at the family lobster pound business, both owned and operated by his father and mother for many years. He purchased his own boat, “Helen’s Pride” that he captained as a commercial fisherman. Don loved the lobster pound business and after he sold his boat, he continued to work the business that has been in his family for over 4 generations. In the 1990s, he took over the family business which he operated right up until the time of his death. Don and Helen spent as much time as they could at their camp in Effingham and Don really enjoyed going to the Fryeburg Fair each year and also enjoyed going hunting with the guys. He will be very deeply missed by his loving family and his many close friends, especially the coffee crew bunch that met every morning at the pound.

In addition to Helen, his wife of over 50 years, Don is survived by his son, Randy Littlefield, Sr. and his wife Sonya of Seabrook, his grandchildren, Candice Littlefield, Christine Littlefield, Randy Littlefield, Jr. and Camden Hill; his great grandchildren, Davin Janvrin and Christian Flynn and his daughter-in-law, LeeAnn Frost.

Don was predeceased by his son, Donald R. Littlefield, III who died in 1990 and his brother, Richard Doyle who died in 1999.

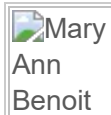

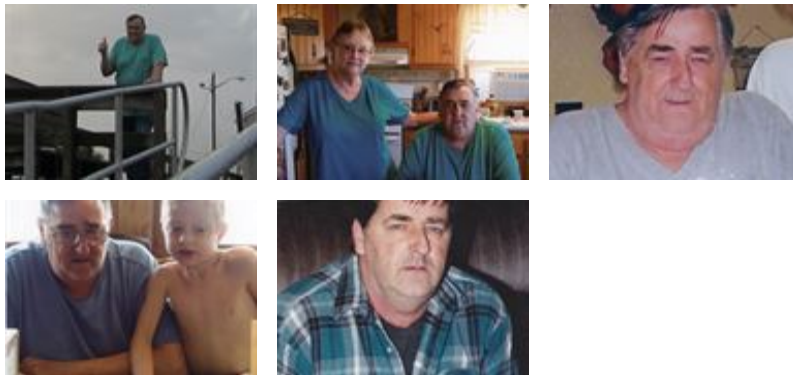

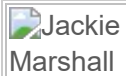
