



Donald P. MacEachern Sr.

May 12, 1931 - March 13, 2015

Seabrook, NH – Donald P. MacEachern, Sr. 83, of Seabrook, died peacefully on Friday, March 13, 2015 at home with loving family by his side.

Donald was born May 12, 1931, in Malden, MA, a son of the late Francis and Catherine (Ryan) MacEachern. He was raised in Everett, MA and joined the Army at 17 years old. Don was a recipient of the Purple Heart for injuries he sustained in Korea. He returned home from the Army and married June (Reddy) MacEachern, the love of his life for 54 years, until her passing in 2006.

The couple settled in Lynn, MA to raise their family. Don worked for Kallenback Plumbing of Lynn for many years before being hired as a maintenance supervisor with the US Postal Service. He retired at age 65. He enjoyed the time he got to spend with his children and their families. He loved sports, especially playing golf with his sons. He was a lifelong member and Past Commander of the Franco-American Legion Post 161 of Lynn.

Don is survived by his sons, Donald Jr. of Lynn, MA, David of Seabrook, and Mark of Saugus, MA; his daughters, Kathy MacEachern and her companion Ray Bourke of Cape Cod, Bonnie Plourde and her husband Ronnie of Lynn and Julie Crampsey and her husband Tim of Salisbury, MA; his sisters, Doris Roache of FL, Trudy DiMaggio of Boxford, MA and Patricia Fallon of

Seabrook. He also leaves behind his 11 adoring grandchildren and great grandchild and many nieces, nephews and cousins.

In addition to his wife and his parents, Don was predeceased by his brother Francis.

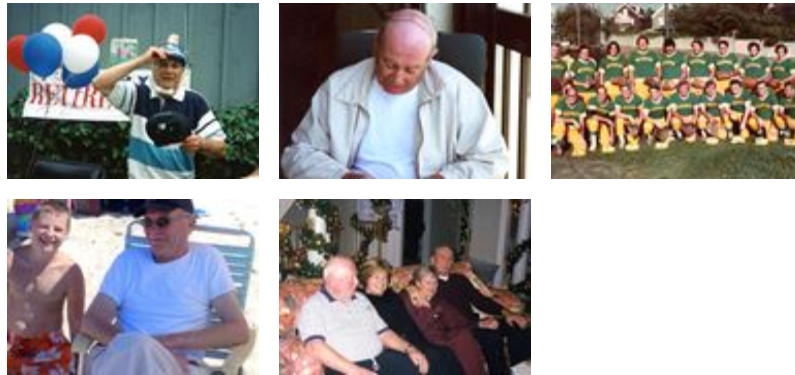
