November 12, 1917 - November 23, 2013

Rye Beach, NH - Dorothy C. (Swift) Blouin of Rye Beach and Deerfield Beach, FL, died Saturday, November 23, 2013 at Hospice by-the-sea in Boca Raton, FL.

She was born Dorothy Catherine Swift on November 12, 1917 in Watertown, MA, to the late Elisabeth (Tiffany) Swift and Andrew Bernard Swift, and was the oldest of 10 siblings. She married Charles P. Blouin in 1938, and together they raised four children. They lived in Waban, MA, in the winters and summered in Rye Beach. After her husband's retirement, they left Massachusetts and started to spend winters in Florida, first in Pompano, and later in Deerfield Beach. Dorothy enjoyed the snowbird life of South Florida, but loved coming back to the Northeast every late spring to spend time with her beloved family. She enjoyed gardening, and was very particular of the beautiful roses that would bloom every spring upon her return. Charlie and Dorothy were married for 53 years until his death in 1991. As the years went by, she took great joy in seeing her family grow as her grandchildren became adults and started families of their own.

Dorothy was a devout Catholic and was a member of the Parish at St. Theresa in Rye Beach. Her faith was a foundation for both her life and the life of the family that she raised. Over the years she would always remind her family that she was praying for them, and through her faith and prayers she

was able to find comfort and peace.

She is survived by three siblings, Robert Swift of Burlington, MA, Richard Swift of Watertown, MA, Marjorie Swift, of Watertown, MA; her four children, Virginia McCann of North Hampton and John's Island, FL, Charles P.
