Stratham – Dorothy Doyle, 95, of Stratham, died peacefully Sunday, January 25, 2015 at her home with her family at her side.

She was born in Philadelphia, PA, October 1, 1919 the daughter of the late Harry and Yvette (Boucher) Ross.

Raised in Philadelphia she graduated from Simon Gratz High School with the Class of 1935.

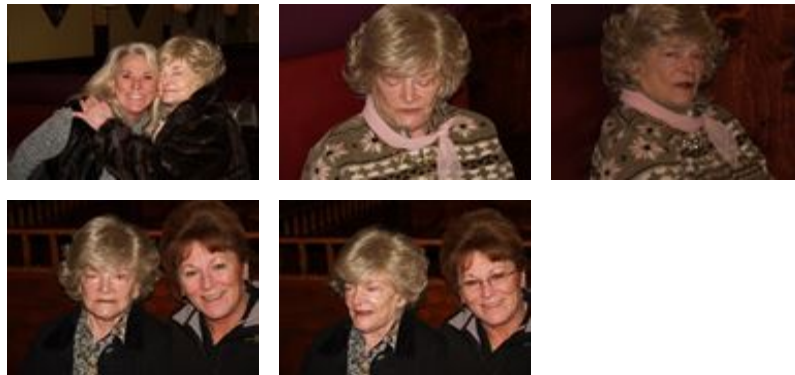
