Seabrook – Earl E. Hart Jr., 54, of Seabrook, passed away on Thursday, August 18, 2022.

He was born in Exeter on July 7, 1968. A lifelong resident of Seabrook, he graduated from Winnacunnet High School, Stratham Community College with his CAD certificate and later attended Charis Bible College.

Proudly serving in the United States Navy for 4 years he returned home and started his gun smith business, which he owned and operated up until his passing.

Earl enjoyed four wheeling, his late dog Elli, the outdoors and spending time at his second home in Otis, Maine. He was a longtime member of the New England Christian Church, where he served as an usher and was a member of the prayer team.
