Hampton – Edie M. Pole, 80, of Hampton, and a former longtime resident of Sanford, ME, passed away peacefully at the Exeter Hospital on Friday, June 30, 2023. Edie was the wife of Gary J. Pole, Sr. and they shared over 31 years of beautiful marriage together.
