North Andover – Edward Hajjar, 67, of North Andover and Rye, NH, died Thursday, September 8, 2016 at Hyder Family Hospice House in Dover, NH surrounded by his loving family.

He was born August 30, 1949 a son of the late Edward G. and Selma (Hajjar) Hajjar.

Ed received his bachelor degree in 1982 from Fitchburg State College where he later received his master's degree.

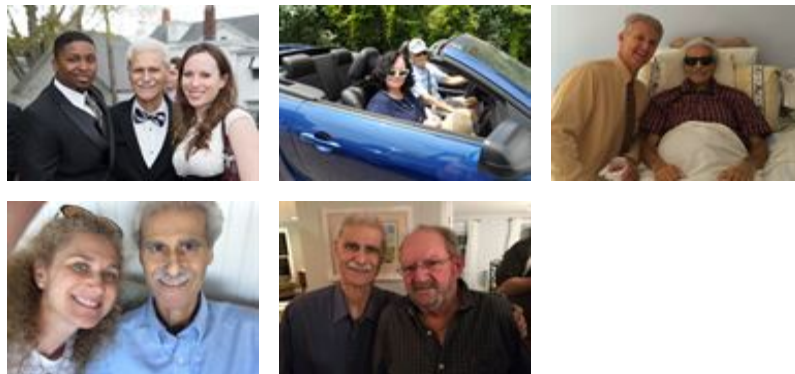
