



Edward Everett Pierce

April 27, 1933 - November 28, 2023

Hampton - Edward Everett Pierce, age 90 and longtime resident of Hampton passed away peacefully on Tuesday, November 28, 2023, at Whittier Rehabilitation Hospital in Haverhill with his family by his side. He was the loving husband of Carol Ann Pierce.

Born on April 27, 1933, Edward was the son of the late Everett W. and Elizabeth (Marsh) Pierce. Raised and educated in Wilton, Edward attended the Northfield Mount Hermon School and graduated in 1952. From there he attended Boston University and went on to enlist in the United States Army where he proudly served his country during the Korean War. Ed worked for the US Postal Service in Lynn, Massachusetts for 33 years. In his younger days he was an avid skier. He loved music, especially jazz, blues, and country. He also liked a good beer now and then. Carol and Ed met at a cookout in Beverly, MA. At the time, they were both students, Ed at BU, and Carol at Salem Hospital School of Nursing. They were married on October 27, 1957, at St. Mary's Church in Lynn, Massachusetts.

In addition to his wife, Edward is survived by his children; Kevin Pierce and his wife Linda of Jacksonville, NC, Mary Ellen of North Hampton, Christopher Pierce and his wife Therese of Peabody, MA, Steven Pierce and his wife Sherrin of Cody, WY, David Pierce and his wife Linda of Northborough, MA, and Sister Jennifer Pierce of Namur, Belgium.
