North Hampton - Edward A. "Eddie" Robinson, 56, of North Hampton, died suddenly Saturday, February 10, 2018 at his home.

Eddie was born April 23, 1961 at St. Mary's Hospital in Milwaukee WI to Jean M. (Denissen) Robinson of North Hampton and the late Richard G. Robinson.

A North Hampton resident for 44 years, he graduated from Winnacunnet High School and attended the NH Vocational Technical Institute in Portsmouth. He was self employed serving local residents with services including tree trimming, auto repair, and property maintenance. He was incredibly creative and willing to support people in any way he could. Since the passing of his father in 2006, Eddie was especially caring and supportive of his mother who is also a long time North Hampton resident.
