Stratham – Elaine Marie Dray, passed away peacefully on October 29, 2024, at the age of 98. Born on April 6, 1926, in Worcester, MA, Elaine was the cherished only child of the late Leo and Mary Violet (Palmer) McDonough. She shared a loving marriage of 64 years with her husband, Robert J. Dray, until his passing in 2015.

Elaine grew up in Worcester, MA, and after graduating from Worcester State Teacher's College, she dedicated herself to teaching 5th-grade English. In November 1951, she married Bob and devoted her life to raising their family. As a mother of eight, Elaine's greatest joy was being with her family. Her imagination was on great display over the years cooking wonderful homemade dinners, including desserts, for a family of 10 (sometimes more!). Her heart and soul were in the loving care of making Thanksgiving, Christmas, Easter and family birthdays memorable. Elaine, known to us as Mom, loved the ocean and many enjoyed rides with her along the New Hampshire and Maine seacoasts, appreciating the beauty in that love.

She loved excursions driving down Cape Cod 6A, visiting the Mansfield Country Store and the Village Barn. She was passionate about Boston sports, especially the Larry Bird Celtics era and the Tom Brady Patriots. The first snowfall of the year thrilled her.

Elaine personified “content” in all things. She was always sending thoughtful cards and notes. Goodbyes after family and friend visits often included tears. Elaine was a quiet, yet strong, intelligent, articulate, wise, witty woman, who gave her best, especially to those she loved. She will be greatly missed.
