Hampton – Elaine M. Schaake, 87, of Hampton, died Friday, February 5, 2021 at Cornerstone in Hampton after a period of failing health with family by her side. She was born June 8, 1933 in Portsmouth a daughter of the late George and Ruth (Richards) Goodreau.

Elaine was raised in Rye and graduated from Portsmouth High School and Westbrook College in Maine. Well known in the Seacoast area, Elaine ran the Surf Gift Shop in Salisbury, MA and later the Casino Gift Shop in Hampton Beach. Many have fond memories of their time with Elaine, be it at the Gift Shop, the Whales Tale, the Ashworth Hotel, or other well-known establishments in the area.

In her earlier years she was active at St. Theresa Church in Rye Beach. She shared 53 years of marriage with her husband the late Fred J. Schaake, Sr. who predeceased her in 2014.

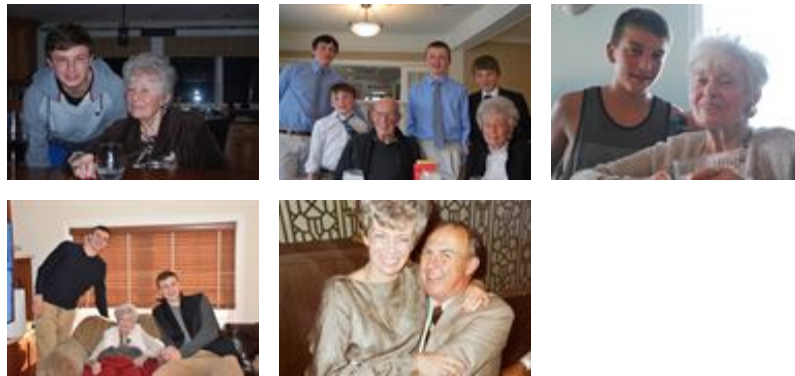
