North Hampton – Elizabeth R. “Betty” Coffey, 83, of North Hampton, passed away peacefully with her son at her side on Saturday, December 20, 2025.

Born in Exeter, NH, on November 2, 1942, she was the daughter of the late William and Rose (Moreau) Bragg. Raised in Exeter, Betty graduated from Exeter High School with the Class of 1960. Following graduation, she enlisted in the United States Navy and proudly served for three years.

Betty dedicated many years to her work as a housekeeper in several facilities, including over 20 years at Portsmouth Regional Hospital.

An avid walker, she logged countless miles along the seacoast and in her hometown of Exeter. She cherished road trips, especially her annual visits to Pennsylvania Dutch Country to spend time with her Amish friends. Betty loved puppies, adored babies, and enjoyed music from the 1950s rock and roll era, big band, jazz and swing. Above all, she will be remembered for her kindness and her willingness to go out of her way to help others.
