March 12, 1953 - February 21, 2022

Rochester – Eloise “Ellie” H. Kimball, 68, of Rochester, passed away peacefully on Monday, February 21, 2022 after a brief illness. She was born in Kittery, ME on March 12, 1953, a daughter of the late Edward E. Kimball and Eleanor (Pickering) McKenna.

Ellie was raised mostly in Rye with her beloved grandmother. The family relocated to Exeter where she graduated from Exeter High School with the Class of 71. After high school, Ellie enrolled at the former Portsmouth VoTech and studied to become an LPN. She worked at the Rockingham County Nursing Home for over 15 years before having to leave due to disability.

Since becoming disabled herself, Ellie was always an advocate for others in her position and served as Chairwomen of the Governor’s Council for Disabled Transportation. Along with her mother and sister, she was also active in the VFW Auxiliary.

Ellie had a dry wit, could be considered sarcastic at times and was also known as being a jokester on occasion. She had several interests including scrapbooking and card stamping. She loved her family above all else and she will be sadly missed.

Left to cherish Ellie’s memory are her sister, Beth Kimball of Rochester, her

nieces and nephews; Dave Kimball of Somersworth, Sarah Shaw of Dover and Kayla Martel and her husband Travis of Dover; her great nieces and nephews; Collin and Jacob Shaw and Haleigh Kimball and Zachary Martel and her sister in law, Cindy Kimball. She also leaves her special friend, Donna Fischer of Nashua.

In addition to her parents, Ellie was predeceased by her brother, Edward Kimball who died in 2020.
