Brentwood - Eugene Raymond Guilmet, 66, passed away June 18, 2013 after a courageous fight with kidney cancer. As he was in life, Gene was surrounded by those who loved him.

Gene was born September 16, 1946 to Lucian and Althea (La Roche) Guilmet. As a boy he loved fishing and camping. He graduated from Tenney High School in Methuen, Massachusetts in 1964 and enlisted in the Navy where he trained as a communications expert and was stationed in Rota, Spain. Upon his discharge, he attended Salem State and graduated with a degree in business. His experience in the Navy proved more beneficial than he thought as he later founded Seacoast Electronics in 1998 and remained the owner and president until his retirement in 2008. As a semi-retiree, he pursued his realtor license and worked with Tom Fabisak Realty.

As anyone who knew Gene could attest, he loved his retro-inspired Heritage Softail, and his "+HD+" license plates. His love for his home life, particularly his backyard "slice of paradise," that he built with his wife, was always at the forefront of his life.
