July 22, 1924 - March 6, 2017

Durham – Evelyn J. Sullivan, 92, of Durham, formerly of Hampton, died Monday, March 6, 2017 at Brookdale Sprucewood in Durham.

She was born in Somerville, Mass., July 22, 1924, the daughter of the late Lawrence A. and Gertrude E. (Hanlon) Dewire.

She was a 1942 graduate of Notre Dame Academy in Boston and a 1946 graduate of Emanuel College. Mrs. Sullivan also resided in Cambridge, and Needham, Mass., before moving to Hampton in 1998 where she had been a life long summer resident.
