



Forrest C. Brown

November 5, 1929 - May 3, 2024

Forrest C. Brown, 94, died May 3rd, 2024, from natural causes. He was born in Exeter, NH on November 5, 1929, the son of the late George & Clara Brown of Hampton Falls, NH. Forrest is the husband of Charlyn Brown with whom he shared 61 wonderful years of marriage.

Growing up on a dairy farm, Forrest graduated from University of New Hampshire's Thompson School of Agriculture. He'd later work for the U.S. Postal Service as a rural mail carrier, but it was his contributions as a volunteer that impacted the lives of many in Hampton Falls.

He spent over 20 years on the Volunteer Fire Department including Fire Warden, 17-year member of the Town Planning Board including Chairman, Town Auditor, Trustee of the Historical Society, and Trustee of Hampton Falls Cemeteries including Chairman. In addition, he enjoyed being a member of Hampton Academy/Winnacunnet Alumni Association, Hampton Youth Association Baseball Coach, Assistant Cubs Scout Master, Order of the Eastern Star and 71-year member of the Saint James Lodge No. 102 in Hampton.

Forrest had a lifelong passion for farming, whether it was raising animals, planting large vegetable gardens and flower beds, or restoring his 1949 John Deere tractor. He also loved spending time at his cottage on Great East Lake,

the Red Sox and being with his granddaughters Ellie and Liliana.

Forrest is survived by his wife Charlyn and his son Glenn along with his wife Karina of Holliston, MA. He was the very much-loved Grandpa to Ellie and Liliana. Forrest is also survived by two sisters, Joyce Marelli and Janice Smith, as well as several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his brother, Donald Brown.

A graveside service will be held on Thursday, May 16, at 11 AM at the Westview Cemetery on Nason Road in Hampton Falls, NH 03844.
