Hampton – Frank M. DiPastina, 66, of Hampton, formerly of Stamford, CT, died unexpectedly at his home on Thursday, May 29, 2014.

Frank was born September 8, 1947 in Boston, a son of the late Angelo and Julia (Malwitz) DiPastina. He was raised in Stamford, CT and was a 1965 graduate of Stamford High School. After school, he enlisted in the United States Army and honorably served in Korea. Upon his discharge, Frank went to work for Metro-North Railroad of Stamford until his retirement in 2008 after more than 36 years of service. While in Stamford, Frank was a member of the VFW, the Cardinal Club, the White Eagles and the Elks. He married his friend and companion of over 30 years, Jacqueline “Mumz” (Cunningham) DiPastina in 2001 and after his retirement from the railroad, the couple moved to Hampton. In Hampton, Frank was a member of the Raymond E. Walton American Legion Post 70 of Seabrook. He was a loving husband and father and will be sadly missed by his family and his many friends.

In addition to his wife Jackie “Mumz” DiPastina, he is survived by his stepson Joseph Ramer of Hampton, his stepdaughter Tracy Ramer of Portsmouth; his brothers, William DiPastina and his wife Darlene of Milford, CT and Robert Malwitz and his wife Marie of Stamford; his sisters, Kathy Gerardi of Milford and Roseanne Buchanan of Alabama; his granddaughter Courtney Ramer and his many nieces and nephews.

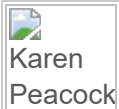
