



Frank Logan Follansbee

August 29, 1918 - February 23, 2016

Hampton, NH - Frank L. Follansbee age 97, of Deer Isle, ME, died Tuesday, February 23, 2016 in Hampton.

He was born in Boston, MA, and resided in Deer Isle, ME for the last 33 years. He was married to the late Sally Follansbee for 42 years who predeceased him in 2014.

Frank volunteered for active duty with the Army Air Corp during WWII. He became a B-17 pilot and was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for successfully returning from a mission and saving his crew as the sole survivors of his squadron.

Mr. Follansbee worked various jobs throughout his life which included sales representative, owner of a Donut Shop in Newburyport, Mass., and a Rock and Mineral shop in Hampton Falls.

He was active in animal welfare and served on the Board of The Ark Animal Shelter for many years.

He is survived by his brother, 3 stepchildren, 3 daughters and 6 grandchildren.
