Hampton – Fred C. Tobey, III, 86, of Hampton, died Monday, May 2, 2022 at his home with family by his side after a period of failing health. He was born in Lawrence, MA July 22, 1935 a son of the late Fred C. Tobey, Jr. and Grace E. (Powell) Tobey.
