Greenland - Gary Edward Davis, 79 years old, passed away on Saturday, April 30, 2022, surrounded by his loving wife and children. Gary was born on June 17, 1942, to the late Virginia (Dockham) Brown and the late Ralph Davis. He graduated from Raymond High School in Raymond, NH in 1960 and immediately enlisted in the US Navy. He proudly served his country for 27 years.

Gary met his true love, Jeanne McCann, in 1963 and they were married on August 14, 1965. Together, Gary and Jeanne raised their family while moving around the country for his Naval career. He retired from the Navy in 1987 as Master Chief of the Command at the Polaris Missile Facility where he worked on nuclear weapons. After retiring from the Navy, Gary and Jeanne returned to New England to be closer to their extended family. Gary began a new career at Cabletron in Rochester, NH. Upon his retirement from Cabletron, his days were filled cheering on his grandsons at their various sporting events, watching his granddaughter's dance recitals and traveling the world with Jeanne and their family. He was also the past Commander of the Greenland Veterans Association.

Gary is survived by his wife Jeanne, his son Robert Davis, his daughter Darlene Drew and her husband Kyler and his grandchildren, Joshua Drew and his fiancée Marce, Jonathan Davis and his fiancée Becca, Katia Drew,

Andrew Davis, Ryan Drew and William Davis. He is also survived by his two sisters, Doretta Dockham and Heidi Brown. He was predeceased by his infant son, Kenneth Scott Davis.

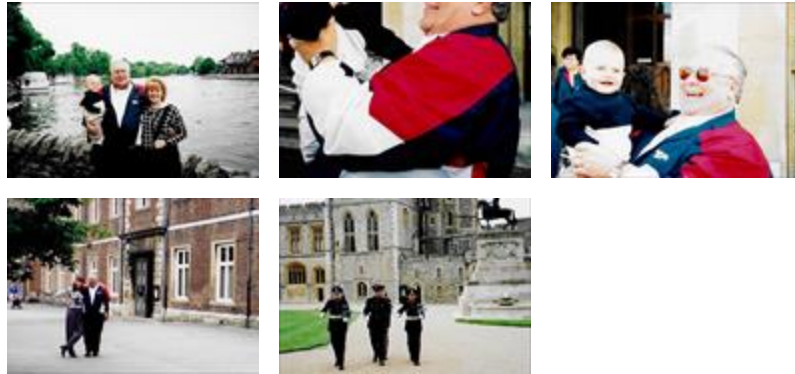
