Hampton – George H. Brown, Jr., 90, of Hampton, passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday morning, January 15, 2023. He was born in Portsmouth July 1, 1932 a son of the late George H. and Josephine (Keough) Brown and shared over 64 years of beautiful marriage with his late wife Glenna J. (Fernald) Brown who predeceased him in 2018.

George was raised in Portsmouth and graduated from Portsmouth High School with the Class of 1950. He was a veteran serving with the US Navy and was employed in quality assurance at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard, retiring in 1986 after 32 years of service.

He had made his home in Hampton since 1958, was an active communicant of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal Parish, a member of the Holy Name Society and Knights of Columbus Council 5093. He was a past Grand Knight of the council.

He leaves his five children, Stephen Brown and his wife Cheri of Portsmouth, Theresa McGinnis and her husband Henry, Patricia Adams all of Hampton, Joan Annis and her husband Gary of Rye, Thomas Brown and his wife Lisa of Middleton, MA, 13 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren.

In addition to his wife and parents he was predeceased by his sister Mary

Shepard.
