Hampton - George Ross McCreary, of Hampton, passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 23, 2023, at Partridge House in Hampton, with his wife, Beibei, by his side. He was 85 years old.

Born on February 02, 1938, in West Grove, PA, George was the son of the late George and Leta (Muckle) McCreary. George is survived by his wife Beibei McCreary, of Hampton, and his children, Lorelei Davis and her husband Spiro of Exeter, John McCreary of Seabrook, and Tiffany McCreary of Hampton. Dan McCreary and his wife Wanda of Wisconsin. He is also survived by his little sweetheart and cheerleader, his granddaughter Anastasia.
