Seabrook – George W. Staples, 89, of Seabrook died Friday December 14, 2018 at his home with family by his side.

He was born in Seabrook January 17, 1929 the son of the late Ralph J. and M. Elizabeth (Sanborn) Staples.

Mr. Staples was a graduate of Dover Trade School and Essex Agricultural School. He was a Korean War veteran serving with the US Army.

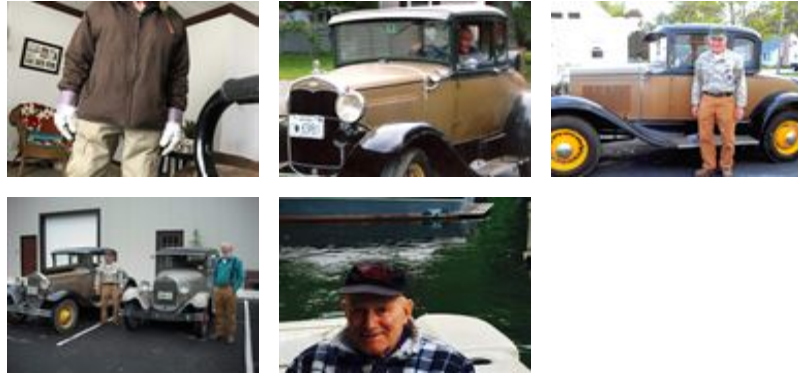
