



Gerald J. Kittredge

March 24, 1930 - January 10, 2015

Exeter – Gerald J. Kittredge, 84, of Exeter, formerly of Manchester and Hampton, died peacefully on Saturday, January 10, 2015 at the Exeter Hospital.

He was born March 24, 1930 in Manchester the son of the late Gerald E. and Catherine R. (O'Toole) Kittredge.

Mr. Kittredge graduated from St. Joseph High School for Boys in Manchester with the Class of 1948 and from Temple University in Philadelphia, Penn. in 1953. He excelled in basketball both in high school and college. He was inducted into the Manchester Catholic High School Hall of Fame as well as the Queen City Hall of Fame.

He was employed as the credit manager for Southworth Milton Machinery in Hopkinton retiring in 1986 with 26 years of service. He had been employed part time at the Sagamore Golf Club in North Hampton as recently as the fall of 2013.

Mr. Kittredge made his home in Exeter since 1999 coming from Hampton and had previously lived in Manchester. He was a former communicant of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal parish in Hampton.

He shared 59 years of marriage with the late Lucia Y. (Battistelli) Kittredge who predeceased him in 2010.

Family members include four children, Stephen Kittredge and wife Janice of Auburn, Michael Kittredge of Rye, Gary Kittredge of Hampton and Manchester, Mary Jane Coutu and husband Ray of Hampton, three granddaughters, Erin Bocherer of Columbus, OH, Allison Bourget of Allenstown, Sara Armitage of St. Paul, MN, five great grandchildren, two sisters, Patricia LaChance of Yuma, AZ, Elizabeth Bouchard of Bedford, nieces and nephews.

He was also predeceased by his sister, Kathleen Hadley.
