



Gerard "Gerry" Verville

September 1, 1922 - January 30, 2017

Newmarket – Gerard J. “Gerry” Verville, 94, of Newmarket and a former longtime resident of North Hampton, passed away peacefully on Monday, January 30, 2017 at the Hyder Hospice Unit in Dover.

Born in Montreal, Quebec, Canada on September 1, 1922, Gerry was one of 11 children of the late Aime and Bertha (LaPlante) Verville.

Gerry worked as a truck driver for the former Badger Trucking and Gypsum Hauling and retired from Gypsum after more than 35 years.
