



## Harold F McLeer

September 27, 1934 - December 2, 2023

HAMPTON - Harold F. McLeer, 89, of Hampton, passed away peacefully Saturday, December 2, 2023 at his home in Glen Hill.

Born in Brooklyn, NY on September 27, 1934, he attended city schools and graduated from St. Francis College (Brooklyn) in 1956 with a BBA in Accounting.

Harold was a well-established CPA, having worked in Portsmouth, NH for many years for one of the largest accounting firms in New Hampshire and Vermont at the time, the former Smith, Batchelder & Rugg. He will be best remembered for his quick wit and "dry" sense of humor; being a staunch Democrat and his love of baseball.

Growing up just blocks away from Ebbets Field in the Flatbush section of Brooklyn, he was a Brooklyn Dodgers fan throughout his childhood and then an "ardent" NY Yankees fan after their move to Los Angeles in 1957.

He is survived by his three children, Christopher M. McLeer of Hampton, NH; Lisa A. (McLeer) Saar of St. Petersburg, FL; Robert F. McLeer of Hollis Center, ME; and grandsons Colin Saar, Daniel McLeer and Michael McLeer. He will also be deeply missed by numerous lifelong friends.

In addition to his parents, Harold was predeceased by his wife of 62 years, Loretta, in 2021; his daughter, Paula M. McLeer in 2018; his son-in-law, Ronald V. Saar in 2016 and his brother, Joseph McLeer.

Services are being held on Monday, December 18, 2023 at 10 AM at Remick & Gendron Funeral Home, 811 Lafayette Road, Hampton. Burial will follow at High Street Cemetery, Hampton, NH.
