She was born in Lowell, MA, February 15, 1920 the daughter of the late Daniel F. and Annie J. (Vesey) Leary. Raised in Lowell, she resided 25 years in Methuen, MA and 30 years in Seabrook, NH before moving to the home of her daughter and son in law, Lois and Donald Martin of Wells, Maine in 2011.

She began working at age 11 caring for a family and their household, and then worked for the former Educator Crax Factory in Lowell, then as a fabric mender for the Arlington Mills. She later worked 28 years in electronics repair at Western Electric in Andover. She was an exceptional seamstress, loved knitting, crocheting and cake decorating.

She was the wife of William J. Cormier, who died in 1990.
