



## Henry B. Fuller

May 19, 1949 - March 1, 2024

North Hampton - Henry B. Fuller, 74, of North Hampton, passed away peacefully, surrounded by his loving family, on Friday, March 1, 2024. He was born in Fryeburg, ME on May 19, 1949, to the late Phillip and Rose Fuller (Waldren).

Raised in Seabrook, Henry grew up on the New Hampshire seacoast, spending time in Seabrook, Hampton, and North Hampton. In high school, he enjoyed playing baseball and football and running track, earning an award for the most touchdowns in a single game in 1967.

Henry graduated from Winnacunnet High School in 1968. Following graduation, he embarked on a career as a carpenter, working for himself and founding his own carpentry business, 3F Construction. In addition to his carpentry work, he held a roofing license and certifications in window installation as well as serving as an elected member of the North Hampton Water Commission for over thirty years.

He began construction on his own home in North Hampton in 2002, completing it in 2006. A true labor of love, Henry built his home exactly as he liked, featuring a large, beautiful kitchen where he delighted in entertaining friends and family.

A passionate outdoorsman, Henry enjoyed deer hunting with a bow and arrow, taking pleasure in cooking venison and making venison sausage. He was also known for his talent in baking fresh pies.

Henry will be fondly remembered for his friendly and outgoing personality, his creativity, and, above all, his honesty.

Surviving family members include his brothers Dale Fuller and wife Anne of Hudson, and Franklin V. Fuller of Hampton Falls. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his sister Holly A. Welsh.

A celebration of Henry's life will be held in his beloved home on Saturday May 4th from 1-4 pm at 86 North road, North Hampton, NH 03862 . A private burial will follow in Hillside Cemetery, Seabrook.
