Portsmouth – Henry S. Krebs, 83, of Portsmouth, formerly of Epping and Manchester, died Monday, May 20, 2013 after a long illness. His loving family was at his side.

He was born in Exeter, October 23, 1929, a son of the late Harry and Mildred (Tarbox) Krebs.

Mr. Krebs was a 20 year veteran of the United States Air Force, retiring as a Master Sergeant in 1968. After retirement he worked for the NH Crime Commission for 12 years as their Regional Planning Coordinator.

Mr. Krebs was raised in Amesbury and graduated from Amesbury High with the Class of 1948. He later earned his bachelor's degree from UNH. Henry lived in Manchester for 21 years before moving to Epping in 1985. He recently moved to the Edgewood Center due to illness.
