



## Hilaire "Eli" Lavoie

December 14, 1951 - November 18, 2016

Hampton – Hilaire “Eli” Lavoie, 64, of Hampton, died Friday, November 18, 2016 at Exeter Hospital after a sudden illness.

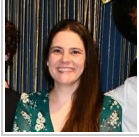

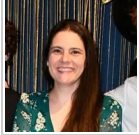
