Portsmouth - Ian Alexander Keith, 40, of Portsmouth passed away on Sunday, May 12, 2019 after a long illness. Ian was born in Newburyport, Massachusetts on December 7, 1978 and grew up in Hampton, graduating from Winnacunnet High School in 1997.

He is survived by his parents Donald and Betsy Keith of Portsmouth and by his two sisters, Sarah Ingram of Hampton and Emily Keith of Portsmouth. He last worked with Columbia Sportswear of Kittery, Maine and is best remembered for his intelligence, wit and loyalty, highlighted by his prodigious knowledge of popular music from the 1950's to the present day.
