She was born in Malden, MA on February 25, 1936 a daughter of the late Clarence and Ina (Porter) Patten.

Raised in Revere, MA, she graduated from Revere High School with the Class of 1954.

Ina dedicated her life to raising her family and was a former member of the Parkway Assembly God Church in Revere. She enjoyed Red Sox games, especially David Ortiz, reading her favorite scripture, Isaiah 26 Verse 3, watching religious programs, listening to her favorite hymns, writing poems, sewing and crafts, taking care of her cats and feeding all the stray animals. She also enjoyed spending her younger days in Boston with her late sister Daisy and was very proud to at the age of 14 sing in the choir with her late sister Audrey and the late Rev. Billy Graham in front of 50,000 people at the Boston Commons.

Ina shared many years of marriage with her late husband George B. Pottle who predeceased her in 2005.
