



## Irene A. Squires

October 12, 1923 - June 5, 2014

Rye - Irene A. Squires, 90, of Rye, passed away peacefully in the presence of her family on Thursday, June 5, 2014 at Webster at Rye.

She was born on October 12, 1923 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois, the daughter of the late Rudolph and Anne Marie (Huneke) Shade. Originally, she was from Versailles, Indiana and became a registered nurse on September 15, 1945 at Indianapolis City Hospital School of Nurses. Irene was married to John "Jack" Squires in 1953, and would have celebrated 61 years of marriage in August, 2014.

On July 25, 1951 she entered active service in the United States Army Nurse Corp. She was assigned to Tokyo Army Hospital in Tokyo, Japan. As a ward nurse, Irene was responsible for 30 American wounded soldiers. She met Jack who was a 2nd Lt. in the US Air Force and was on duty in Korea. He received a 3 day pass to visit Tokyo for rest and recuperation. While there they met on a blind date, which started a one year courtship. On Jack's return to the United States they were soon united again in San Francisco where they were joined in marriage. Since both were from military families they decided to remain on active duty for the next 25 years visiting many foreign countries.

Irene was a communicant of St. Theresa Parish in Rye Beach. She was a member of the original church woman's organization, and she was very active in many parish functions, including the yearly craft fair, and the fashion show. Irene was especially active in Mother Teresa's Share Group as the "penny keeper" being responsible for the collection of numerous pennies which were

donated by the congregation. She and Jack spent many hours sorting and rolling the pennies which in turn were donated to Mother Teresa's treasury. Irene is survived by her husband John, son Mark and wife Valerie of Rochester, NY; daughter Marisa Jarvis and husband Robert of Pembroke, a granddaughter, Andrea Squires and husband Nate Meyers of Chandler, AZ and grandson, Timothy Squires of Rochester, NY; her brother, Bill Shade and his wife Dale of Gettysburg, PA, and her sister, Emily Voss of Milan, Indiana. Her parents, brothers, Tom and Dick Shade, and her sister, Marie Baker predeceased her.
