Portland, ME – Irving B. Keenan, 93, of Portland, passed away peacefully on Monday, October 22, 2018 at Fallbrook Woods.

He was born in Marblehead, MA on February 4, 1925, the son of the late Henry and Gladys (Brown) Keenan. Raised also in Marblehead, he graduated from Marblehead High School with the Class of 1943.
