Seabrook – Ivan Q. Eaton, Sr., 82, a lifelong resident of Seabrook, died Tuesday, September 23, 2014 at his home after a period of failing health.

He was born in Seabrook, August 10, 1932 a son of the late Charles S. and Liona D. (Eaton) Eaton.

Ivan attended local schools and was a veteran of the US Army serving as a Corporal during the Korean War. He was held as a Prisoner of War after he was captured on November 28, 1950 until his release on August 29, 1953 after the signing of the Armistice.

Mr. Eaton was employed as a shoe worker for the former Barr & Bloomfield Shoe Company and later the Louis Shoe Company in Newburyport. He also worked in plumbing and heating with the late Jerry Locke. He was a member of the Seabrook Fire Department from 1964-1971 and served as the third permanent firefighter for the town.

He was very active in Seabrook town affairs; was founder of the Seabrook Search & Rescue, served as selectman (90-93), planning board (94-95) budget committee (87-90 and 04-07), housing authority, conservation and

pollution control commissions and cable franchise committees and was active with emergency management with the town.

Mr. Eaton was the recipient of the Prisoner of War Medal, was a life member of the American Prisoner of War Assoc., a charter member of the NH American Ex-Prisoner of War Chapter 1, Korean War Veterans Assoc., NH Korean War Veterans Assoc., Chapter 320, life member and past commander of Raymond E. Walton American Legion Post 70 of Seabrook, life member of Exeter D.A.V., 29th Infantry Assoc. and Blind Veterans Assoc.

He was also a life member of the Seabrook Fireman's Assoc., North American Hunting Club, National Rifle Assoc. and AARP.

He shared 60 years of marriage with his wife, Joanne D. (Provencher) Eaton of Seabrook.

In addition to his wife, family members include his son, George Eaton and wife April of Epping, his daughter, Liona Bastable of Seabrook, 9 grandchildren, 11 great grandchildren, his brother, Thomas Eaton, his sister, Emily Blanchard both of Seabrook, his brother-in-law, Edward Provencher and sister-in-law, Evelyn Ortega both of Florida and many nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his son, Ivan Q. Eaton, Jr., his grandson, Ronald Butler, III, five brothers, Frank, Calvin, George B., Charles and Alick Eaton and his sister, Mary Perkins.
