



J. Harold E. "Tad" Carbonneau Jr.

January 15, 1943 - January 28, 2023

East Kingston – J. Harold E. "Tad" Carbonneau, Jr., 80, of East Kingston, passed away on Saturday, January 28, 2023 at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston, surrounded by family. He was born in Exeter on January 15, 1943, a son of the late J. Harold E. and Margaret E. (McLaughlin) Carbonneau, Sr.

Tad leaves his beloved wife of 52 years, Elin M. (Braathen) Carbonneau of East Kingston, NH and his sisters, Mary Louise Bailey of Goodyear, AZ and Kathleen E. Carbonneau of North Andover, MA. In addition to his parents, Tad was predeceased by his brother, Thomas E. Carbonneau.

Tad was survived by daughter Diane Cole and her husband Mark of Dover, NH, son Brian Russell and wife Christine Watts of Durham, NH daughter Live' Hall and her husband Mike of Candia, NH and son Hans Carbonneau and his partner Liz Kelleher of Concord, MA. Tad was blessed with 11 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.

Tad grew up in Exeter and attended St. Frances Academy in Biddeford, ME. After graduation, Tad entered the United States Army where he served proudly as a MP and weapons instructor. From there Tad was recruited to serve as a detective at Fort Boston Army Base in South Boston, MA. Tad continued to serve after his honorable discharge from the Army becoming a

Deputy Sheriff for Rockingham County, NH. After many lengthy years serving his country, he founded Eikern Tree Service based in Hampton Falls, NH. He was a full-time volunteer coach servicing youth hockey and baseball leagues all over the New Hampshire Seacoast, including NHE Youth Hockey and HYA Baseball and was a member of the Booster club at Winnacunnet High School. Tad proudly supported the East Kingston, NH Police and Fire departments for the remainder of his life.

Visiting hours will be from 2 to 5 PM on Sunday, February 5, 2023 in the Remick & Gendron Funeral Home – Crematory, 811 Lafayette Rd., Hampton. Services will be on Monday at 11 AM in the funeral home with burial to follow in the Exeter Cemetery.
