North Hampton – Jack M. Bateman, 81, of North Hampton, died Saturday, November 12, 2022 at Oceanside Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation in Hampton with his loving wife by his side. He was born June 8, 1941 a son of the late Joseph F. and Gertrude H. (Macdonald) Bateman.

Jack graduated from Lawrence High School with the Class of 1960, attended Northern Essex Community College and always felt that his greatest achievement was earning the title of United States Marine. He was honorably discharged as a Staff Sargent from the US Marine Corps in 1968. He was a member of Hampton's American Legion Post 35.

At the age of 43, he successfully completed a grueling 13 weeks at the Massachusetts State Police Academy. He graciously served in public safety for 34 years from law enforcement to Director of Emergency Services.

He shared 45 years of marriage with the love of his life Pamela F. (Noury) Bateman.

In addition to his wife he leaves numerous nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his parents and siblings Joseph F. Bateman, Jr., Robert and Richard Bateman and Harriet Bateman Fremont-Smith.
